### NOTICE OF RACE

#### **1 ORGANISING AUTHORITY**

This event will be organised by Strangford Lough Yacht Club (SLYC).

#### **2 RULES**

The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing and the Prescriptions of the RYA.

#### **3 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

4.1 The event is open to all boats of the following classes:

Class

IRC1&2

NHC

Impala

NHCRS

Sonata

Elite

Note that the above classes may be split or amalgamated depending on the number of entries received.

4.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at [www.slyc.co.uk](http://www.slyc.co.uk) and submitting it together with the required fee.

4.3 The entry fee is £60 for entries received on or before 15th September 2023, with an additional late entry surcharge of £30 for entries after that date.

4.4 Boats entering IRC must provide a copy of their 2023 IRC certificate unless they have already provided to SLRCA.

4.5 The closing date for entries will be 12 noon on the 22nd September 2023.

## **5 SCHEDULE**

Weather permitting, there will be two races each Saturday giving a total of 10 races. The first Warning Signal will be at 1330.

## **6 COMMUNICATION**

Before and during racing, the race committee may communicate to competitors on VHF channel 37, call sign "Trasnagh Battery". This may include notification of changes to sailing instructions and announcing premature starters.

## **7 MOORINGS**

SLYC will endeavour to arrange suitable moorings in Whiterock Bay for visiting yachts whose owners request this facility, provided their entries are received by Friday 15th September. Yacht owners borrowing moorings do so at their own risk as all are privately owned and are not maintained by SLYC.

## **8 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 per incident.

## **9 PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded for the best performance in every race in each class. These will be presented in the Clubhouse after racing each Saturday when the Bar will be open and soup will be served.

Prizes for the first and second boats in each class in the series will either be presented in the Clubhouse after the final day's sailing on 21st October or at a Frostie Prizegiving dinner which we are hoping to revive and arrange. Details to follow.
